Pursuant to Iowa R. Civ. P. 1.402(4), I move to amend the petition I filed on 2-8-2024.

Pursuant to Iowa R. Civ. P. 1.911(1), I file this Motion to Continue.

**Introduction**

1. Her Honorable Judge Bethany Currie of the Story County Court Case # LACV053674 has ordered me to submit an Amended Petition to the District 2B Court by this Friday, June 14. I am working diligently to finish that urgent, tedious, stressful, and trauma-reliving task. I do not have time to work on that case and this one at the same time, with overlapping due dates, especially due to the amount of stress involved for me with regard to the torts of the defendants in this case and the Story County case. I filed both cases when I did so they would be filed within the limitations period, and have hit-the-ground-running to catch up on these lawsuits as soon as my college semester ended.

2. Case # 05771 LACL157953 and LACV053674 are interrelated, however they do not appear to me to need to be joined. I do not anticipate requesting a joinder between these two cases, however the outcome of that case could help the court to decide this case. It may be in the court's best interest to continue this case until after that case has moved forward or been resolved. Doing so would also provide me with sufficient time to amend my petition for this case.

3. Assistant Attorney General Christopher Deist, appearing on behalf of the State of Iowa, filed

a Motion to Dismiss on May 22, and on June 4 resisted:

- My motion for Judge Gronewald to recuse herself, and
- My motion to continue this action until a later date.

Asst. Gen. Deist raised numerous arguments which could be addressed ahead of time via an Amended Petition. I require time to address each of the State's arguments, and to number each paragraph so that the Petition conforms to standard.

4. Iowa Rules of Civil Procedure Rule 1.402(4) allows a party to amend a pleading once as a matter of course at any time before a responsive pleading is served. Defendants have not served a responsive pleading.

5. I am acting within the deadline for which a resistance could be filed with regard to the State's May 22 filing. In lieu of a resistance, I move to amend my petition.
