Iowa businesses become CRC-Certified to join the program.

2.) CRC Vouchers Fund the Work

Vouchers fund meals, materials, equipment, and worker training.

3.) Farmers Post Jobs

Rural Iowans submit projects through a simple online portal.

4.) Work Gets Done Locally

Certified businesses hire workers and complete restoration projects.

5.) Communities Are Restored

Barns are saved, jobs are created, and rural heritage lives on.

Production Crops

Food-producing plants that define the primary harvest of a Guild.





Symbol	Ecological Role	Meaning
	Primary Crop	Main crop that helps form the productive backbone of the Guild. Growers may choose any mix of Primary Crops, or just one, without interrupting the Guild's ecology.
	Culinary Crop	Herbs, greens, and flavor crops that are ecologically compatible with the Primary Crops within the Guild. Some Culinary Crops also have Support Crop characteristics that directly benefit the Guild.

* Indicates a crop group rather than a fixed species. Growers may choose from a list of crops and varieties compatible with that Guild.



Ecological Support Plants





Plants included to help stabilize the ecological function of the Guild.

Symbol	Ecological Role	Meaning
	Insectary / Pollinator	Flowering plants that provide nectar and pollen for bees and other pollinating insects while also attracting beneficial predators (e.g. hoverflies, lacewings, parasitoid wasps) which eat pests.
	Aromatic / Chemical Defense Plant	Plants that release volatile compounds or root exudates that deter herbivores, confuse pest host location signals, or improve plant health through antimicrobial or allelopathic interactions.
	Nitrogen Fixer / Soil Builder	Plants that improve soil fertility by fixing atmospheric nitrogen or building soil organic matter
	Trap Crop	Plants intentionally used to attract pests away from primary crops.

Symbols describing the physical architecture of the garden.

Symbol	Ecological Role	Meaning
	Guild	A structured planting module of Crops and Support Plants that grow well together. Based on functional ecology rather than traditional "companion planting" (many such pairings have proven to be false).
	Set	Three Guilds make up a Set. Each year, all Guilds are rotated one position within the Set to prevent them from returning to the same spot for 3 years. Greatly reduces risk of soil disease and pests.
	Satellite	A specialized add-on crop structure (e.g. container, vertical element) attached to a Guild and rotating with it each year. Benefits from its assigned Guild's Support Crops.
	Indoor Germination Required	Crops that typically must be started indoors before hardening, and then transplanting outdoors, under Iowa growing conditions.

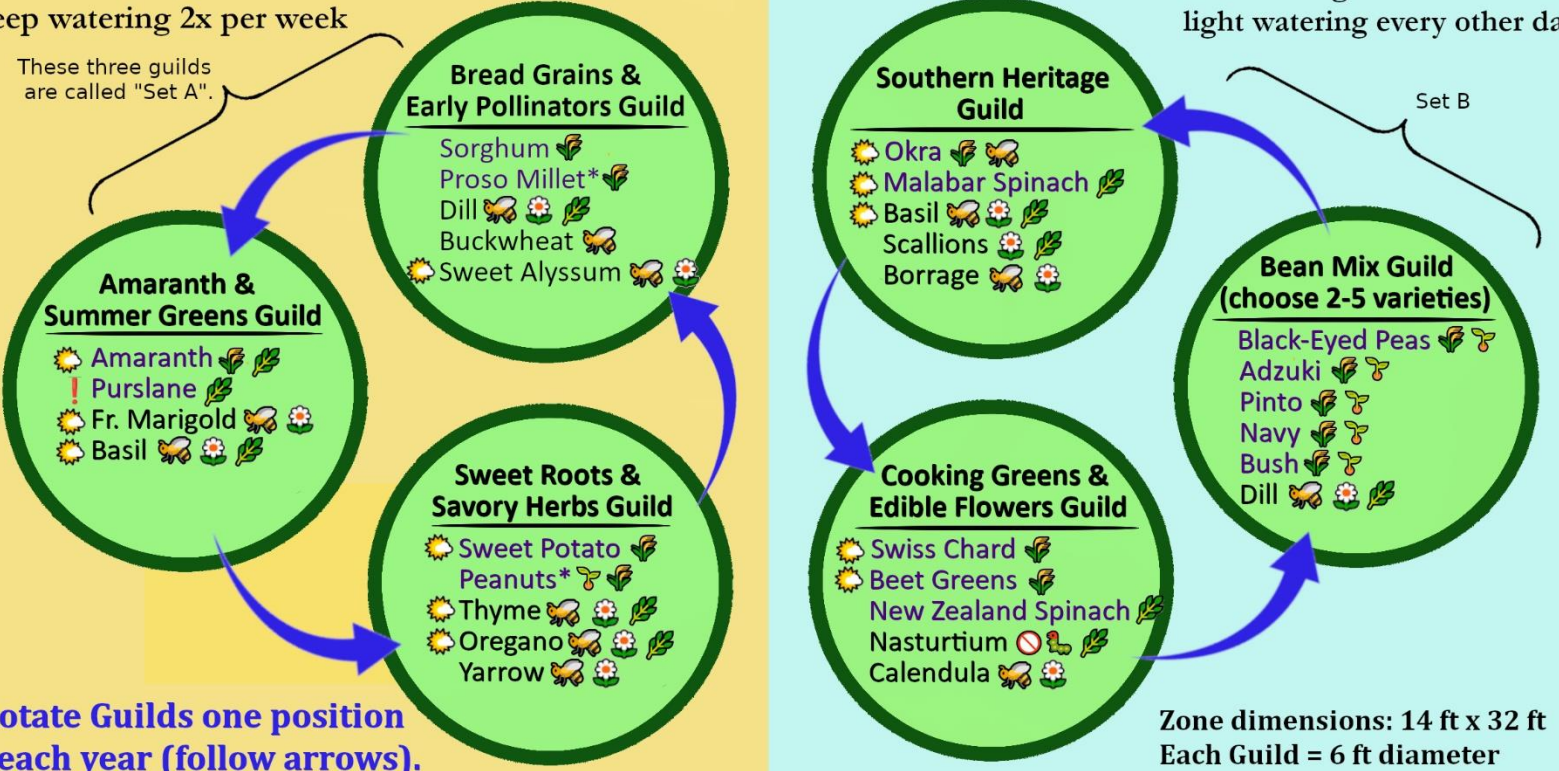

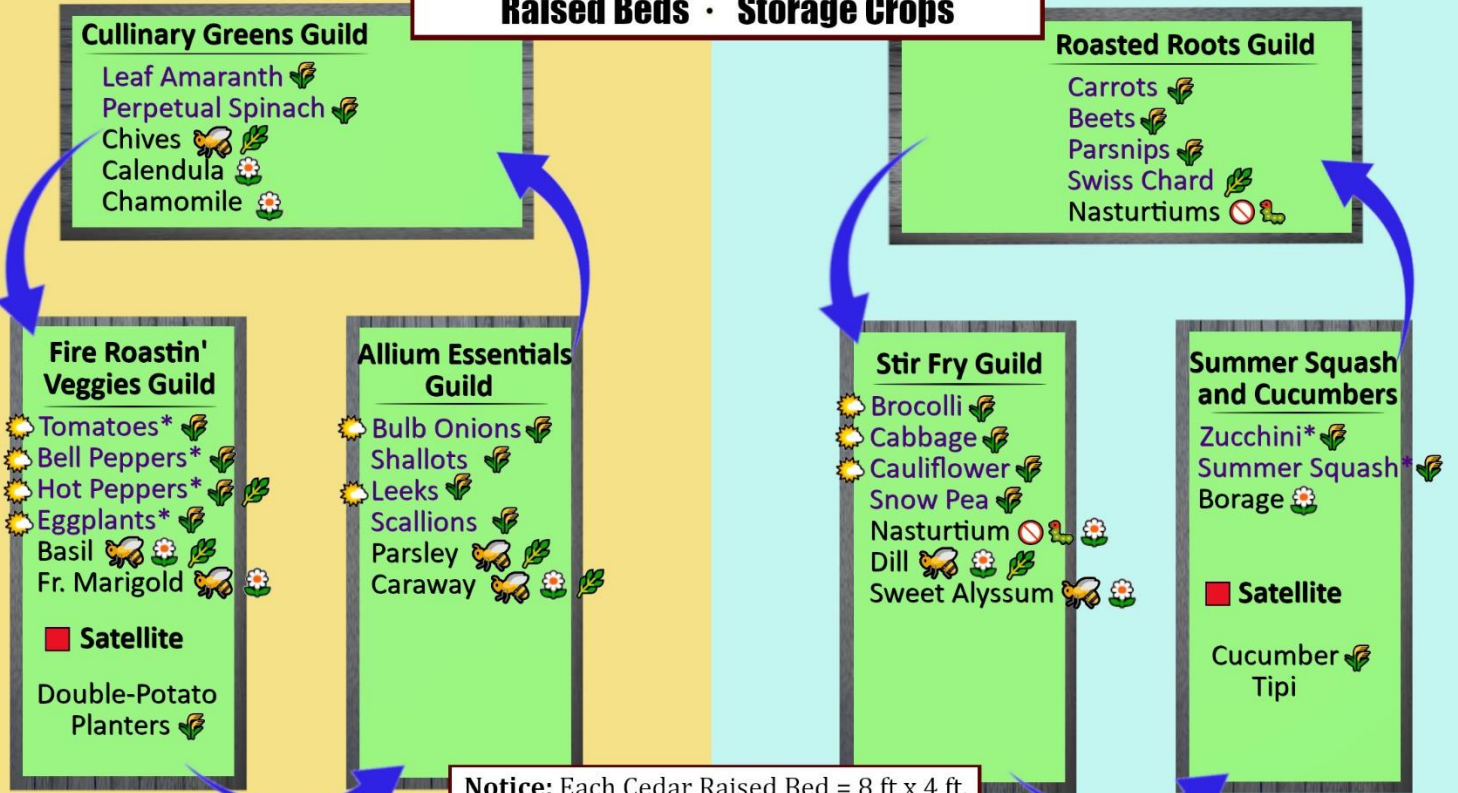



Iowa Reinvestment Act



How Iowa builds and reinvests in its own economy:

- ★ A new stock exchange to invest in CRC projects
- ★ A public credit union to fund farms, homes, and startups
- ★ CRC Vouchers that offset costs and reward local spending
- ★ An Inventor's Guild to protect ideas and reward innovation



CRC LEGISLATIVE ACT — SCFA

The "Set the Captives Free!" Act



A compassionate work release program based on Iowa values:

- ★ Giving inmates a second chance
- ★ Reducing sentences through meaningful work
- ★ Supervised rehabilitation with on-site mental health care
- ★ Lowering taxes while improving Iowa's infrastructure

PILLAR II — EDUCATION

Preparing Students for the Real World

Education should do more than prepare students for tests.

It should prepare them for life.

Building Skills That Matter

New, adult-led, skill-building programs will be available to all students — both in and after school — including:

- Shop, metalworking, and hands-on trades
- Graphic design and creative disciplines
- Project-based learning where students choose what they build

These programs expand the spirit of an Honors Program to every student — encouraging creativity, entrepreneurship, and real-world problem solving.

Students won't just complete assignments. They'll build things they care about.

A More Inclusive Iowa Starts in the Classroom

Students will also learn how to better support people with disabilities — not just through theory, but through real understanding.

This includes:

- Basic sign language exposure
- Guest speakers and assemblies led by people with disabilities
- Practical guidance on when to help, when not to help, and how to help respectfully

The goal is simple: **build a society where fewer people have to ask for help — because others already understand.**

Teaching Law, Rights, and Responsibility

Attorneys and legal professionals will step into classrooms to teach:

- The difference between civil and criminal law
- How the legal system actually works
- Civil rights history — including Iowa’s own civil rights leaders

Students will graduate with a real understanding of their rights — and how to protect them.

Responsibility, Safety, and Civic Duty

A new “**G.I. Joe Program**” will bring veterans and trained officers into classrooms to teach:

- Gun safety and responsible handling
- The importance of protecting others
- The responsibility that comes with constitutional rights

This program focuses on early education — reaching students before misinformation takes hold.

Healthcare That Works for Every Iowan

Healthcare in Iowa is at a breaking point.

Families are navigating red tape, denied coverage, and rising costs — while caregivers are stretched thin and rural access continues to decline.

This isn't sustainable.

A New Healthcare Compact for Iowa

The United Iowa Healthcare Compact — also known as **SondraCare** — is a two-tiered system designed to deliver both:

- **Universal access to essential care**
- **Long-term economic stability for Iowa's workforce and healthcare system**

It replaces a system built on complexity and denial with one built on:

- **Mercy and compassion**
- **Fairness and accountability**
- **Efficiency and economic responsibility**

How It Works

- **Tier One** guarantees essential healthcare for every Iowan — with no co-pays, no deductibles, and no coverage gaps
- **Tier Two** expands coverage through workforce-based benefits, strengthening employee retention and supporting Iowa businesses

This model doesn't eliminate the private sector — it **partners with it**, creating new opportunities while ensuring no one is left without care.

Healing People — Strengthening Iowa

SondraCare is designed to do more than fix healthcare.

It is built to:

- Support caregivers with better pay and stability
- Keep healthcare professionals in Iowa

PILLAR IV — JUSTICE REFORM

Justice That Works for the People

Iowa's justice system is too complex for the people it is meant to serve.

Today, navigating a civil case can require understanding hundreds of procedural rules, costly legal representation, and a system that often prioritizes process over fairness.

For many Iowans, justice is not denied outright — it is simply **out of reach**.

Restoring the People's Role in Justice

As Abraham Lincoln once said:

“The people are the rightful masters of the courts.”

But a system that ordinary citizens cannot understand or access cannot truly belong to them.

Operation: Magna Carta II is about restoring that balance.

A Simpler, Accessible System

This plan restructures Iowa's civil justice system into something every Iowan can use:

- A **clear, step-by-step legal process** replacing hundreds of fragmented procedural rules
- **Downloadable forms and guided filings** available to the public
- A **public legal database** organizing court rulings by category for easy reference

Justice should not require a law degree to pursue.

Making Justice Affordable

Today:

- The average attorney costs **\$200+ per hour**
- The average Iowan earns around **\$18 per hour**
- Over **90% of low-income Iowans cannot afford legal representation**

This creates a system where rights exist on paper — but not in practice.
