This matter comes before the court, Waterman, McDonald, and May, JJ., on: (1) the court’s own motion concerning the court’s jurisdiction to consider this appeal; and (2) appellant’s motion to file a supplemental response to appellee’s jurisdictional statement, motion to waive prepayment of filing fee, and motion to accept combined certificate.

The court grants appellant’s motion to file a supplemental response to appellee’s jurisdictional statement.

Upon consideration of the statements filed by the parties in response to this court’s prior order, including appellant’s supplemental response, and without reaching the issue of whether the appeal is moot, the court concludes the appeal is untimely. The appeal was not filed within 30 days of the district court’s order denying petitioner’s first motion to reconsider, and petitioner’s second motion to reconsider did not extend the time for taking an appeal. *See* Iowa R. Civ. P. 1.904(4); Iowa R. App. P. 6.101(1)(c).

The court dismisses the appeal for lack of jurisdiction. Appellant’s other motions are denied as moot.
